

Unforgettable Summer 2025 50/50 Raffle in Support of Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care

Official Raffle Rules

License Number RACJ L-00665, held by Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care.

50/50 RAFFLE

1. This is a 50/50 raffle, where the winner will receive fifty percent (50%) of the gross proceeds from ticket sales. The prize will be sent to the winner by check. The other half will be retained by Le Phare to help fund respite services for families during the summer season, after covering the minimal fees of the raffle administration platform.

ELIGIBILITY

2. Participation is strictly reserved for individuals aged 18 and older who are physically present in the province of Quebec at the time of ticket purchase.
3. The following are not eligible to participate: administrators and employees of Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care, the company providing the electronic raffle system and technology, and the company providing the electronic payment system for ticket purchases (collectively, the "Organizers").

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

4. There is one (1) way to purchase a ticket and enter the raffle.
5. **Electronic Ticket:** Tickets will be sold exclusively online at all times during the sales period through the Rafflebox platform at <https://www.rafflebox.ca/fr/raffle/phare2025> by following the instructions and agreeing to the applicable transaction terms. Internet access, a compatible device, and an electronic payment method by credit card are required. Once the purchase transaction is completed, a digital receipt listing all the ticket numbers purchased will be emailed to the address provided at the time of the transaction.
6. Tickets are sold in bundles as follows: 5 tickets for \$25; 20 for \$50; 100 for \$150; or 250 for \$250. There is no limit on the number of tickets a person can purchase.
7. Tickets are valid for one draw only and cannot be used in future raffles.
8. As per provincial law, no charitable tax receipt may be issued for raffle ticket purchases.

DRAW AND WINNER NOTIFICATION

9. **Sales Period:** June 15, 2025 to July 20, 2025, at 11:59 PM (Eastern Time), inclusive.
10. **Draw Date:** The draw will be conducted online using the Rafflebox platform and a Random Number Generator (RNG) on Wednesday, July 23, 2025, at 10:00 AM (Eastern Time).
11. **Winner Notification:** The winner will be contacted by phone and email by a staff member of Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care within forty-eight (48) hours following the draw. Before claiming the prize, the holder of the winning ticket must sign a standard release form confirming compliance with the rules, acceptance of the prize as awarded, and releasing Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care from all liability related to the draw, the prize, and its use. No substitutions or transfers of the prize will be allowed. The selected winner will have fourteen (14) days from the date of notification to return a signed copy of the release form to Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care. If the selected winner fails to comply within the given timeframe, another ticket holder will be randomly selected, and the initially selected winner will forfeit the prize without recourse against Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care or any other parties involved in the draw.
12. **Announcement of Winner:** The winning ticket number will be posted on the Rafflebox platform and on Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care's Facebook page following the draw.
13. **Prize Acceptance:** By participating in this raffle, each ticket holder and the winner agree to:
 - Comply with these official rules and all decisions made by Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care;
 - Release and hold harmless Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care, its directors, officers, employees, agents, and representatives from all liability for claims or damages, including but not limited to personal injury or property damage, related to the acceptance or misuse of the prize or participation in the draw;
 - Permit Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care to use their name, city, and province of residence for promotional purposes across Le Phare's communication platforms.
14. **Final Decision:** All decisions made by Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care regarding this raffle are final and binding on all participants.

15. **Liability:** Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care is not responsible for lost, stolen, illegible, or destroyed ticket purchase receipts.
16. **Raffle Cancellation:** Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care reserves the right to cancel or suspend the raffle in the event of fraud or any other circumstance beyond its control that could compromise its administration, security, fairness, or integrity, subject to approval by the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec.
17. **Compliance with Applicable Laws:** This raffle is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations. Personal information collected from participants will remain confidential and be used solely for the administration of the raffle.
18. **Disputes:** Any dispute regarding the organization or conduct of the raffle may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec for resolution. However, any dispute regarding the awarding of the prize may only be submitted to the Régie for the purpose of intervention to settle the matter.
