Message from the Chair and the Executive Director

The year 2024-2025 was a turning point for Le Phare. The year was defined by profound transformations as we continuously innovated to provide better support and comfort to seriously ill children and their families. This year, we are proud to have inaugurated new spaces and environments, like our nursing station and pharmacy, which have been fully redesigned to meet the specific needs of children and healthcare personnel. Our Snoezelen room has been completely renovated to provide a unique multi-sensory space, emphasizing our constant desire to provide a soothing and stimulating environment that is fully adapted to the rhythm of each child.

Throughout the year, we expanded our services in response to the realities faced by families. Last November, we launched a brand new component for our bereavement support program dedicated to parents stricken by perinatal loss. The addition of a social worker to our team also helped us strengthen and increase our support for families across Quebec.

Now in its 25th year, Le Phare remains an essential pillar of pediatric palliative care within communities. This turning point has strengthened our vision and enabled us to prepare for the future with ambition and commitment.

Constantly Evolving Support

Thanks to its respite services, end-of-life care, and bereavement support services, Le Phare continues to support a growing number of families, which are referred to us by our hospital and community partners. True to our interdisciplinary approach, our team continues to share its expertise actively both in Quebec and abroad. This year, we collaborated with Pallium Canada to launch the first ever French-language community of practice in pediatric palliative care. We also helped create the Collectif Polyhandicap, bringing together organizations that work with individuals living with multiple disabilities. These initiatives illustrate our desire to innovate, build bridges, and promote best practices for the benefit of all families facing these unimaginable challenges.

The coming year will see a number of new projects designed to enhance our service offer, particularly our bereavement support program, to better meet the growing psychosocial support needs of Quebec families. We face the future with confidence and determination, strengthened by our expertise and our ongoing desire to excel while remaining true to our values.

We thank all those who helped make this possible.

We wish to express our deepest gratitude to our donors, partners, board members, and volunteers, along with Le Phare team members. Your support helps us provide much-needed respite, comfort, and essential care to those who have turned to Le Phare. Testimonial

A Lighthouse on My Path

In January 2003, I was told: “You have been selected for our volunteer training course.” A few simple words that would transform my life. Here I was, immersed in the world of pediatric palliative care at Le Phare, Children’s Palliative Care. I did not know what to expect at the time, but I soon realized that the experience would leave an indelible mark on my heart.

Throughout the training course, and my many years of work at Le Phare, I discovered a unique world that is both deeply moving and full of light. I learned about fatal diseases, some well known, others known as orphan diseases. I met children whose lives were short on time, but whose every moment brimmed with life and curiosity. They smiled, laughed, tinkered, played, and contemplated. Behind every smile lurked a story, a resilience, a boundless love.

Le Phare is much more than a care centre. It is a refuge, a bubble of respite where families can breathe a little and feel supported, understood.



I began as a volunteer, offering my assistance while listening to these extraordinary children and their families. Over time, I became Family Services Coordinator, a role that gave me a better understanding of the scale of the needs involved and the incredible resilience of parents.

Here, our bonds are occasionally forged in silence through a glance, or a hand squeezed a little tighter. We come face to face with LIFE in all its vulnerability and fragility, but also in its raw power. There are moments of pure joy, like seeing a child explode into laughter as soap bubbles swirl nearby. Other times, silence weighs heavily, charged with emotions that we often dare not name.

Parents, on the other hand, juggle a multitude of roles: nurse, attendant, physio, and the list goes on. And all the while, they remain parents, lovers, and workers. Their daily lives are a succession of treatments and nights shortened by fear and hope. Isolation is common because they cannot take their child everywhere: a wheelchair that is too cumbersome, epilepsy that is difficult to control, an immune system that is too fragile. Every outing becomes an expedition, every day a new ordeal.

Their lives are marked by successive bereavements. They mourn for a “normal” life, for a child who will not grow up like the others, for a future they had imagined differently. Some families show admirable resilience, while others collapse under the weight of grief. And then there are the siblings. Brothers and sisters often retreat, mourning their own loss, the loss of a childhood shared differently.

True to its name, Le Phare is a lighthouse in the night. It helps children live life to the fullest. It gives families space to breathe, to be together with no other goal but to savour the moment.

To this day, the experience resonates with me, as it has for the past 20 years. It has changed the way I look at life, illness, love, and time. It taught me that real strength often comes in the smallest of gestures: a smile, an outstretched hand, an attentive ear. And above all, it taught me that light can persist, even in the darkest places. I wish to extend my heartfelt gratitude to the thousands of families I have had the privilege of working with, and to my cherished colleagues who have since left, along with those who remain.

One thing is clear: all are kindhearted individuals who have helped children enjoy themselves until the end of their lives.

Inaugurating Our New Nursing Station, Pharmacy, and Snoezelen Room

Le Phare recently inaugurated its new nursing station and pharmacy. These modern spaces have been carefully redesigned to provide an environment that is better suited to the complex medical conditions faced by children in respite, along with those at the end of their lives, without compromising the needs of our care team. These renovations, situated at the core of our facility, will help us maintain the highest standards of care while maintaining the well-being of our team, whose vital contributions are essential when caring for children.

Our Snoezelen room has been completely refurbished to provide a high-quality, multi-sensory environment. Designed to promote relaxation, gentle stimulation and well-being, this environment helps children enjoy sensory experiences tailored to their needs.

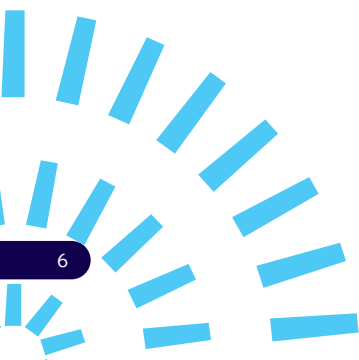

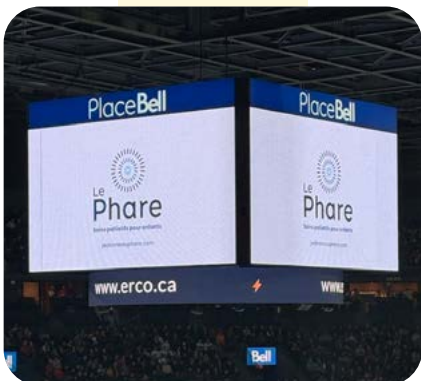

Care and Services Overview

Founded in 1999, Le Phare, Children's Palliative Care is the first pediatric palliative care centre in Quebec. Whether it involves a respite stay, support for symptom management, end-of-life care, or bereavement follow-up, Le Phare provides families with the care and services they need, free of charge.

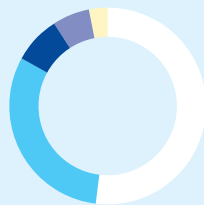

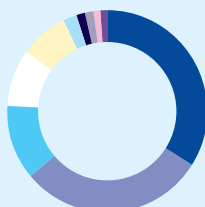

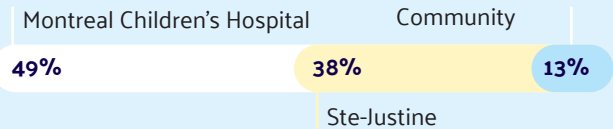

The Respite Program

Enjoying life until the end

Respite is one of the cornerstones of the services offered at Le Phare; it represents 86% of all overnight stays for children and families. Respite helps families take a moment to breathe and take care of themselves and their siblings in an effort to avoid parental exhaustion.

When a child is admitted to Le Phare, parents can return home with complete peace of mind, knowing that every effort is being made to ensure their child's well-being and safety. During this time, children at Le Phare enjoy a caring environment that is fully adapted to their medical needs and abilities. Here, they can flourish despite their illness while enjoying themselves until the end of life.

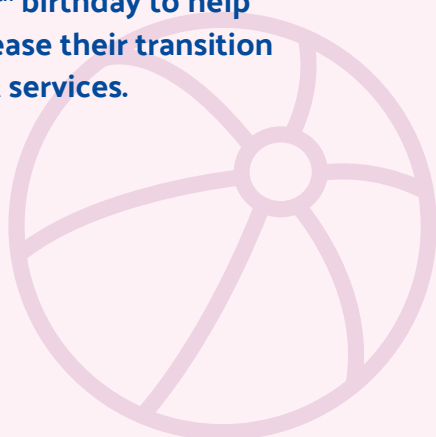

End-of-Life Care Program

Caring, supporting, and living until the last breath

When all hope of a cure has gone, Le Phare offers families comprehensive support through symptom management and end-of-life care. In a warm and family-friendly environment, our approach focuses on comfort, quality of life, and the wishes of the child and his or her family.

Families find refuge at Le Phare. Putting aside their role as caregivers, they can once again become parents. Every moment is precious, and every effort is made to create memories filled with love and kindness.

Thanks to a family suite directly connected to the child's room, family members can stay with the child 24/7, with no time limits. As the end of life approaches, our team provides gentle support with respect for the pace and needs of everyone involved.

The Cultivating Memory Program

Creating, honouring, and remembering

The Cultivating Memory program helps families create lasting and meaningful memories throughout their child's life, especially as they approach the end of life. It includes personalized activities: casting, artistic creations, photos, birthday celebrations, and special moments. Every child is honoured while preserving his or her heritage.

Each initiative is tailored to the family and the child's needs, wishes, and preferred pace. With sensitivity and respect, our care and animation teams work with families to transform the moment into something precious, keeping the child's memory alive.

This year, more than:

activities were held for families: artistic creations, imprinting, and special activities adapted to their wishes (Ferrari visit, family dinner, birthday, etc.).

It is also full of day-to-day moments that help us live in the here and now while shaping the memories of every child's time at Le Phare.

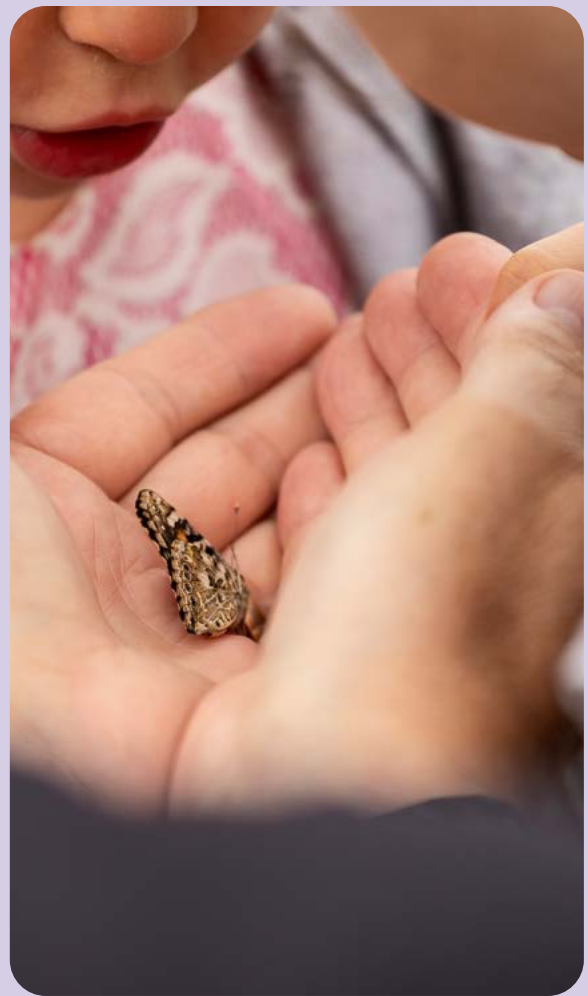


The Psychosocial Support Program

Providing support for the entire trajectory and bereavement period

When a family is faced with an illness that limits the child's life expectancy, its entire sense of normalcy is shattered. Le Phare psychosocial support program offers assistance throughout the illness trajectory.

Le Phare team uses a caring and compassionate approach, supporting families who must face complex decisions. It offers ongoing support for parents dealing with the many bereavements that arise at different stages of their child's illness.

Expertise program

Advancing and transmitting knowledge

Pediatric palliative care is a fast-growing specialty, and Le Phare is actively transmitting the expertise involved at the university and community levels throughout the Quebec healthcare network.

SOME OF OUR COLLABORATIONS OVER THE PAST YEAR:

Promoting expertise

The social workers and Pediatric Palliative Clinical Care Counsellors that make up our team shared their expertise at an event held by the Association québécoise de soins palliatifs (AQSP), as well as at the McGill International Congress on Palliative Care. They discussed their experience creating and running a support group for bereaved parents, a unique approach carefully developed to meet the specific needs of families.

Biomusic

On two occasions, Dr. Silvana Barone, Medical Director at Le Phare, introduced a pilot study known as Creating Interpersonal Links in Pediatric Palliative Care Through Biomusic: first at the American Academy of Pediatrics Conference in Orlando, then at the AQSP.

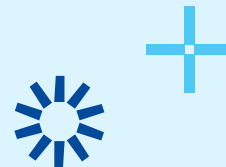
She discussed the promising impact of this innovative approach to enrich interactions between seriously ill children, their families, and healthcare teams.

Inter-agency collaboration: Collectif Polyhandicap

Le Phare played a role in creating the Collectif Polyhandicap, a group of organizations that work with individuals who live with multiple disabilities and their families. The aim of this group is to encourage collaboration and the sharing of practices while raising awareness for the specific needs of this population in Quebec.

A French-language community of practice

In collaboration with Pallium Canada, Le Phare helped create the very first French-language community of practice in pediatric palliative care, offering a unique platform that connects professionals across Canada's francophone community.



The Year According to the Management Committee

The past year has been marked by inspiring challenges and remarkable achievements, reaffirming our conviction that every child with a life-limiting illness deserves access to compassionate, high-quality palliative care within a warm and nurturing environment. Continuous training and fluid communication among care team members are vital to ensuring the delivery of high-quality care. This year, we welcomed a new pediatrician to our medical team and strengthened our vital partnerships with the care teams at pediatric university hospitals. Le Phare has established itself as a key partner in the creation of Canada's first French-language community of practice in pediatric palliative care. We have also made a significant impact at scientific conferences.

All of these advancements are driven by an unwavering commitment to providing children and their families with compassionate, respectful, and kind support at every stage of their journey.

In the coming year, we will focus on advancing our educational and research initiatives to improve knowledge sharing regarding pediatric palliative care, both within Le Phare and across the healthcare community.

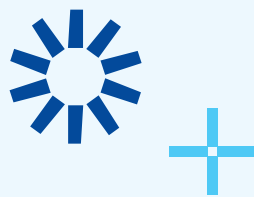
